



How to Count Change for Your Interview

If the purchase is **\$3.59** and the customer paid **\$20.00** you would count the change back as:

Add one penny (\$.01) to make \$3.60

Add one nickel (\$.05) to make \$3.65

Add one dime (\$.10) to make \$3.75

Add one quarter (\$.25) to make \$4.00

Add one dollar bill (\$1.00) to make \$5.00

Add a five dollar bill (\$5.00) to make \$10.00

Add a ten dollar bill (\$10.00) to make **\$20.00**

If the purchase is **\$3.77** and the customer paid **\$10.02** you would count the change back as:

First subtract \$.02 from both amounts for \$3.75 and \$10.00

You can then see that you would only need a quarter in change

Add one quarter (\$.25) to make \$4.02 (\$3.75 + \$.25 + \$.02)

Add one dollar bill (\$1.00) to make \$5.02

Add a five dollar bill (\$5.00) to make **\$10.02**
